1 | SUMMARY OF FUNCTIONS:

As a Technician on the Wind Service Team, you will play a crucial role in ensuring the efficient and reliable operation of our wind turbines. You will work as part of a team, conducting maintenance, troubleshooting, and repair activities on wind turbines to maximize their performance and contribute to our renewable energy goals.

2 | MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct routine inspections, preventative maintenance, and corrective repairs on wind turbines and associated equipment to ensure safe and optimal operation.
- Perform mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic troubleshooting to diagnose and resolve technical issues in a timely manner.
- Utilize SCADA systems and diagnostic tools to monitor turbine performance, detect anomalies, and respond to alarms.
- Collaborate with the Wind Turbine Fleet Manager and other team members to plan and execute maintenance schedules, minimizing downtime.
- Ensure compliance with safety protocols, company policies, and industry standards during all maintenance activities.
- Perform equipment upgrades and modifications as needed to improve turbine performance and reliability.
- Maintain accurate and detailed records of maintenance activities, repairs, and parts usage.
- Assist in maintaining spare parts inventory and coordinate with procurement to ensure timely availability of required components.
- Contribute to the development of maintenance procedures, technical documentation, and training materials.
- Participate in training sessions to enhance technical skills and stay updated on industry advancements.
- Adhere to environmental and sustainability practices, minimizing the impact of operations on local ecosystems.
